RECOVERY ON WHEELS (ROW)

ROW is a bus outfitted to provide access to substance use disorder and recovery services on the spot in real time. Numerous services are available through ROW as it navigates to scheduled locations throughout Cumberland County.

Services include:

- Peer Recovery Coaches
- Direct linkage to treatment & recovery services
- Temporary ID when needed for the purpose of accessing treatment services
- Information & referrals to various social services
- Needle disposal
- Hepatitis A vaccinations
- Health screenings & other health services
- Disposal of prescription drugs & distribution of drug-deactivation Deterra Pouches
- Narcan (opioid overdose reversal) education
